



Kraków in 2026 continues in the right direction

The year 2026 in Kraków will be marked by the completion of several important investments long awaited by residents, as well as the launch of new ones aimed at improving the quality of life for Krakowians. Ahead of us are, among others, activities related to preparations for the construction of a metro line, as well as investments from the “Pact for Kraków’s Districts” and the “Da Się!” (It Can Be Done!) initiative. All of this is possible thanks to the investment programme for which the city has allocated more than PLN 1.5 billion in this year's budget — a record amount.

A number of tasks will be carried out under the mayoral initiative “Da Się!”. The scope of the investment to Ride facility. A new Park&Ride in Bronowice will soon begin construction.

Sports and Facilities for the Youngest

Kraków is investing in sports infrastructure, including the modernisation of KS Grębałowianka’s facilities and the construction of a sports complex in Os. Wolica. A swimming pool will be built at Primary School No. 129. A tender for the KS Wanda sports hall is planned for Q2 2026.

The city is also completing the construction of 11 nurseries in various districts.

Metro Enters the Investment Process

Kraków has formally entered the project phase for building a metro. Early 2026 brought government-level support for the project. The key task for 2026 is to announce a tender for the metro’s technical documentation, based on previous studies and market consultations. Field studies — geological, hydrological, and building monitoring — will begin as well.

City of Events

Kraków will host numerous international events, including Intel Extreme Masters 2026, the Climbing World Cup, the IRONMAN 70.3, and many cultural festivals. 2026 is also the Year of Andrzej Wajda.

Responsible Budget Policy

The city aims to return to budgetary balance. Kraków has been reducing its operating deficit every year and aims to achieve an operating surplus in 2026. The city has also reduced its overall budget deficit and continues to optimize spending and tender procedures.

In the Right Direction

A new website — “In the Right Direction” — has been launched to improve communication between the city and residents. It provides transparent updates on the implementation of mayoral commitments.
