

Congress of Italian teachers in Kraków

The originator and main co-ordinator of the event is Anna Kondraciuk - a graduate of Italian studies at the Jagiellonian University, methodologist and language school owner. Anna Kondraciuk has conducted methodology courses and supported and accompanied foreign language teachers in their work for years.

The aim of the congress being held by the Anima Academy is to popularise the achievements and latest trends in the field of Italian teaching methodology. It will be an opportunity to listen to inspiring lectures delivered by national experts in glottodidactics, to take part in workshops and to gain practical knowledge of the latest foreign language learning tools. The participants can also become familiar with publications on learning and teaching Italian language. The event is also aimed at integrating the community of Italian teachers in Poland.

A number of guests have confirmed their presence, including Ilario Cola from the University of Łódź, Aleksandra Krauze-Kołodziej from the Catholic University of Lublin, Ewelina Greszczuk-Sokół – the headmistress of the Complex of Sports Schools, Agnieszka Iwanicka – a creator of language games, and Sebastiano Giorgi – the editor-in-chief of *Gazzetta Italia*.

Workshops and lectures will be conducted in Italian and Polish. The program of the congress includes coffee breaks, discussion panels and a short recital of Italian songs. Each participant will receive a starter pack and materials for workshops. The lectures will be recorded and made available to participants after the event.
