

The EANS European Congress of Neurosurgery will take place in 2028 in Kraków

Thanks to the efforts of the Polish Society of Neurosurgeons (PTN), supported by PCO Symposium Cracoviense, the annual congress of the European Association of Neurosurgical Societies -EANS, which gathers over 2,000 delegates from around the world, will be held in Poland for the first time in 2028.

The European Association of Neurosurgical Societies EANS is a non-governmental scientific society representing neurosurgeons from throughout Europe. It was founded in 1971 in Prague by delegates from eighteen national societies at the 4th European Congress of Neurosurgery. The Association is an independent federation of European national neurosurgical societies and a fast-growing association of individual neurosurgeons from around the world.

EANS aims to improve the quality of neurosurgical patient care through training, education and research. The primary way to achieve this goal is to enable the exchange of scientific information at the highest level by organizing meetings, symposiums, and educational courses - the flagship event of EANS is the annual Congress, gathering European and world experts in the field of neurosurgery every year.

The EANS Congress is held in a different city in Europe every year and is now being hosted by Poland for the first time, which makes it a noteworthy success. The Polish Society of Neurosurgeons of the Polish Society of Neurosurgeons has tried several times to obtain the rights to organise this prestigious event in Poland. In March this year, the Main Board of the Polish Society of Neurosurgeons decided to make another attempt. In obtaining the event for Poland, PTN was represented and by Prof. Dr. hab. M. D. Radosław Rola from the Medical University of Lublin, who actively participated in the Congress. The EANS Congress in 2028 will be held at the ICE Kraków Congress Centre and will be organised by PCO Symposium Cracoviense.
