Archeological Museum in Krakow

The Archaeological Museum is the oldest archaeological museum facility in Poland, operating since 1850. It is housed in the St. Michael's complex. From the 9th to the 13th century, wood and earth fortifications of Okół ran through this region, while there was the defensive wall of the city from the 14th century. From the 17th century, there was a monastery complex of Carmelites there, then - during the partitions, Austrian authorities adapted the building to become a prison.





The museum collections (about 500,000 articles) come from archaeological excavations as well as from the gifts of explorers and collectors.

The museum has extensive experience in organizing banquets, concerts and social events and cooperates with the best Krakow restaurants. A large representative garden (up to 1000 people) is available to guests, it is possible to erect tents, have interesting lighting arrangement and construct concert stage in it.

Celestat






Branch of the Historical Museum of the City of Kraków

The building called Celestat (a shooting range, from German Zielstätte) located in the Shooters Garden is the historical residence of the Fowler Brotherhood. The Neo-Gothic palace was built in 1837. The Brethren Room was its main part. In 1874-1875, a huge room was added to the Northern wall, called the Shooters' Room, measuring 320 sq m in area and 6 m in height, split in half by Neo-Gothic colonnade. In the modern times, the 19th century interior of the Shooters' Room was recreated to a large extent, including the vaulting dominated by a frieze decorated with portraits of Kraków's marksmen kings. The Brotherhood's symbol and the most important royal insignia – silver fowl – is displayed in the middle of the room. Unique gifts presented by abdicating kings and memorabilia, cups and trophies are displayed before the fowl. Royal marshals' and Brotherhood's authorities' insignia: sceptres, staffs and chains of office are presented separately. The Brethren Room contains documentation of the more modern history of the Fowler Brotherhood. As the Brotherhood is still active, this part of the exhibition is regularly changed and updated. Here you will also find memorabilia showing the Brotherhood's roots in the Catholic faith and culture, as well as close and cordial bond between the Brotherhood and the Pope John Paul II – honorary member of the Fowler Brotherhood.

Collegium Maius Museum of the Jagiellonian University

Collegium Maius, is the oldest university building in Poland. In the year 1400, king Władysław Jagiełło granted the townhouse to the university, which had been bought from Krakow's town councillor. Its remnants are visible in foundations and at the corner of the building (from the side of the Jagiellońska street and the courtyard) in the form of the so-called wild limestone wall, typical for the 14th century. The townhouse was not spacious which is why Collegium expanded over the 15th century by buying neighbouring buildings and building a few more. In the wake of the fires in 1462 and 1492, the buildings were combined into a harmonious complex, creating the arcaded courtyard encompassed by cloisters, and a late Gothic crystal vaulting, at the same time. On the ground floor there were lecture halls. The library (Libraria), professors' common room (Stuba Communis), the vault and theological lecture hall (today's Auditorium) were located on the first floor. The professors' quarters – or residences – were located on the ground floor as well as on first and the second floors. Appearance and character of Collegium changed dramatically during the 1840–1870 Neo-Gothic remodelling, as the purpose of the complex changed: it was now the home of the Jagiellonian Library. In 1949–1964 the Collegium Maius regained its original appearance from before 1840. The building was also repurposed to serve as the seat of the Jagiellonian University Museum and the home to old university collections.




Collegium Novum of the Jagiellonian University






The Collegium Novum building of the Jagiellonian University – currently the seat of the rector and the Dean’s offices of this oldest university in Poland – it was erected in 1883–1887 according to the design of Feliks Książarski. The beautiful neo-gothic Hall located in the heart of the building was the place of the solemn inauguration of the academic year until 2004. To this day, graduations of subsequent generations of graduates and doctoral awards are held here. In its central part, on the high podium, the chairs of the rector and vice-rectors are exposed, while on the side are the seats of the deans. The front wall is decorated with portraits of the founders of the University, and the others - with two monumental works of Jan Matejko (including the famous Astronomer Copernicus, or “a conversation with God”) and portraits of prominent professors of the Krakow Academy. The historical interior of the Hall provides an excellent setting for numerous conferences, scientific meetings and concerts. The hall is also an extremely valued film location.

The Collegium Novum also houses the former lecture room No. 66 (now the Józef Szujski room No. 56), which was the location of the tragic events of Sonderaktion Krakau on November 6, 1939.

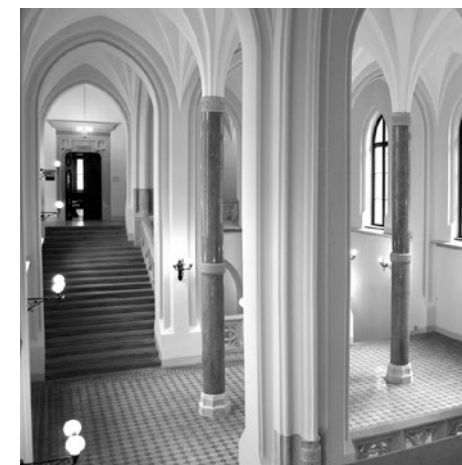

Cracovia Stadium


The Józef Piłsudski Cracovia Stadium is a city sports facility that meets the requirements of UEFA Category 3. The site where the stadium has been located since 1912 is the oldest still used stadium league location in Poland. The current structure of the stadium was created in 2009–2010. It has received many awards and was granted, among others, the Professor Janusz Bogdanowski award granted to the most architecturally successful new building in Krakow. The Cracovia stadium is not only a sports facility, but also a cultural one. It is the venue for various events, including mass events, football tournaments, concerts, fairs, picnics, festivals, banquets and conferences.

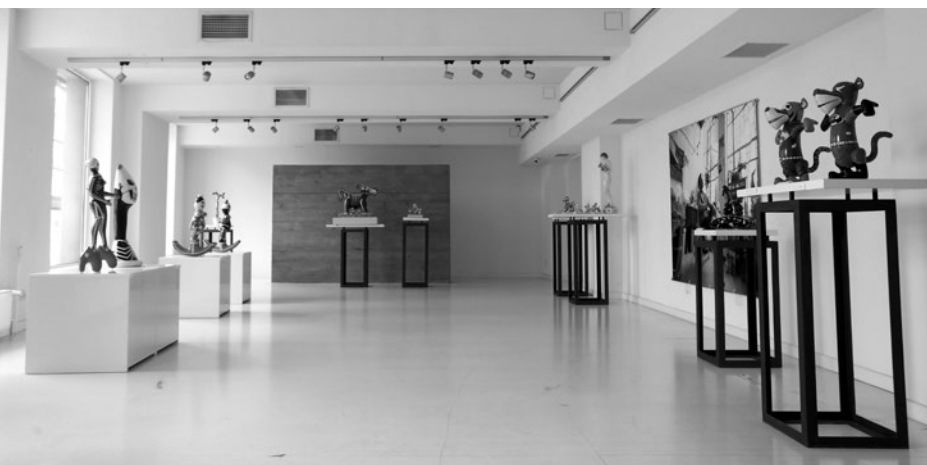







Glass and Ceramics Centre Lipowa 3

The Glass and Ceramics Centre, located in Krakow at 3 Lipowa St., is an initiative of the Krakow Glass and Construction Materials Institute of the Ceramics and Building Materials Institute. It is a place that, through educational, didactic, exhibition and cultural activities, brings Krakow residents and tourists closer to the history and technology of glass art. It is the only place in Krakow that provides the opportunity to visitors to witness a demonstration of hand-moulding live glass as well as the chance to try their hand at the steelworker – glassmaking profession. The museum section is devoted to a permanent exhibition on the history and technology of glassmaking. "Glass in Krakow: Industry and Art. 1931-1998" includes a collection of original tools used for creating hand-made glass, a collection of antique glassware from the turn of the 19th and 20th century, and a collection of contemporary artistic coloured glasses that were made in 1969- 1998 at Lipowa 3.

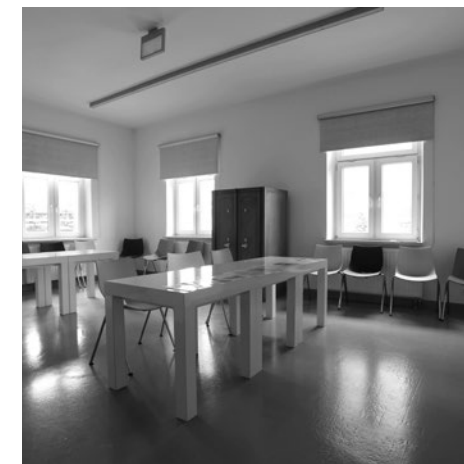

Henryk Reyman Municipal Stadium – the VIP area

The VIP area is located on the West Stand of the Henryk Reyman Municipal Stadium – the place where Wisła Kraków, the 13-time Polish Champions, play. The interiors are arranged in a business style and the sporting atmosphere, that emphasizes the unique character of the place, makes the VIP area an original choice for (business meetings, conferences and banquets. The Małopolska Garden of Arts

The Małopolska Garden of Arts, as a branch of the J. Słowacki Theatre, is an experimental space, operating at the interface between different arts, with the greatest emphasis on music and visual activities. A modern, five-storey building opened in 2012, combines historical elements (it was inscribed in the former nineteenth-century equestrian hall) and modernity. The designer is the architectural studio of prof. Krzysztof Ingarden. This building has received numerous awards, including the “Building of the year 2012” award in the category of culture granted by the ArchDaily.com site, and by one of the most important chapters in the world of design – A’ Design Award. Thanks to its architecture and interiors, it can also be used to organize tall kind of events.






The multi-functional stage hall at level 0 has two independent amphitheatre stages facing each other, seating a total of 299 people. It is possible to organize events using one or both stages, the space between them is 6 m × 16 m.

On level -1 there is a cinema room – 78 places arranged like an amphitheatre, which can be used for small conferences, meetings, trainings, mini recitals, monologues. On the same level, there is a small workshop room (75 m²) with the possibility of dividing it into two.

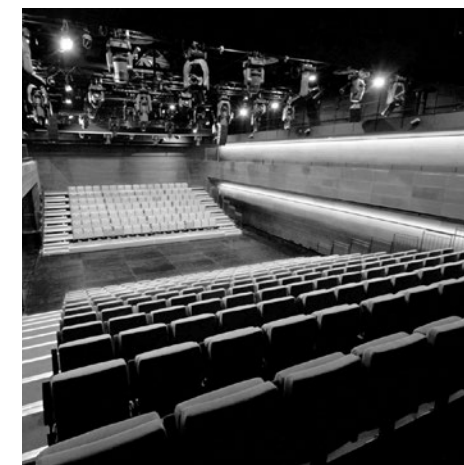

Museum of Contemporary Art in Krakow MOC AK

MOC AK Museum of Contemporary Art in Krakow, which opened on 19 May 2011, is the first post-war institution in Poland founded and purpose-built from scratch for the presentation of international contemporary art.






The architectural design of the Museum was selected in 2007 through an international competition, with the winning concept created by Claudio Nardi Architects from Florence. Some of the main building is a completely new construction, all the other premises are adaptations of the Schindler Factory halls, retaining its shed roof design, which has become the visual signature visual of the whole. The total exhibition area of the museum is nearly 4 000 m², while the total area of the complex is some 10 000 m².

The MOC AK programme comprises presentation of Polish and international most recent art as well as education, research and publishing projects. The Museum's exhibition activity also includes works of writers and musicians. The goal of the museum is to transform the perception of contemporary art so that it may become an important and compelling voice in key public debates.

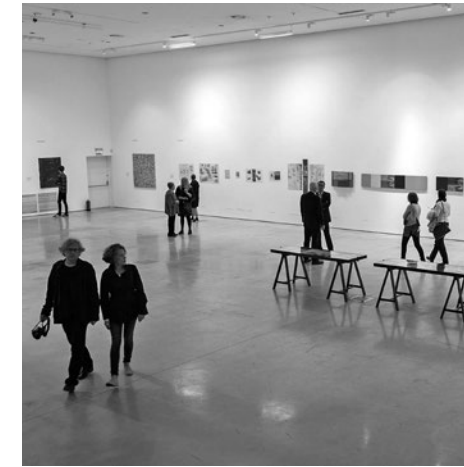

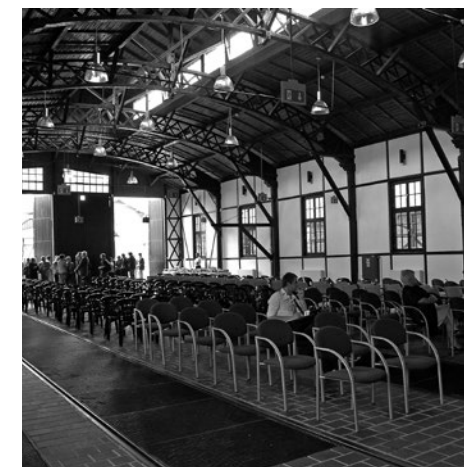

The former Huta Administrative Centre was built in 1951–1955 according to the design of Janusz Ballenstedt, Janusz Ingarden and Marta Ingarden. It is one of the most important examples of socialist realism in the city of Krakow. Many inspirations from the Renaissance style can be found there, including the attic that crowns the building and richly decorated interiors. The complex consists of two symmetrical, spacious buildings erected on a square plan with a side length of 50 m with a square courtyard inside. On the north there is a Z building, which was designed in the past for the head office and the pass office of Krakow Huta, and on the south, there is an S building for the technical library, which also has a large Theatre Hall and Civil Defence Shelters. The building includes two large rooms available for rent for events – the Historical Conference Hall (the Z building) and the Theatre Hall (the S building).

Niepołomice Royal Castle

The Royal Castle is located in the centre of Niepołomice, opposite the market square and next to the historic plant park. It has been beautifully restored and is a true treasure in this small, mediaeval and quaint town. For centuries, the castle was used as a relaxation residence for royals, also known as, "the second Wawel". Here, with the powerful force of chakra, the Kings and Princes from the Piast and Jagiellonian dynasties, as well as the elected leaders of the two nations worked and played. This magnificent castle building has fought against time and the turbulent events in history and has left a true to life book of our history. Currently, it has been meticulously restored and is a gem of Renaissance architecture, it is living proof of the unbelievable artistry of Tomasz Grzymała and the Italian sculptor, Santi Gucci. The castle was founded on a square plan, with a large arcade courtyard and gallery that today is used for both culture and art. In the castle chambers, a museum was opened to show the rich hunting (mammals and fish) exhibits of Włodzimierz Puchalski and from the National Museum. The crowning moment of the restoration works was when the luxury boutique hotel and conference centred was opened. This is now under the management of the Foundation for the Royal Castle in Niepołomice.

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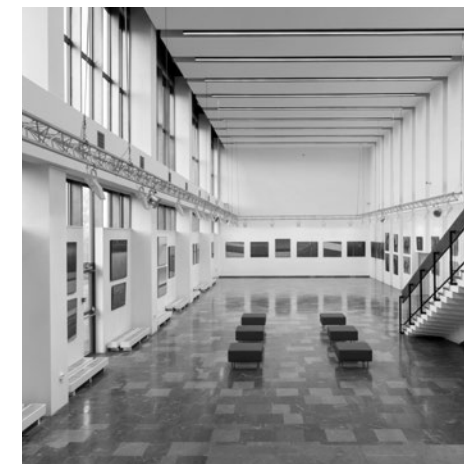

Pallace of Art

The Palace of Art in Krakow is the seat of the Society of the Friends of Fine Arts established in 1854 – the oldest in this part of Europe. After many years of efforts to create a new home, necessary due to the lack of space, after considering many concepts, the Society received a place in 1897 for the construction of the Palace on the edge of Szczepański Square in exchange for the “Grimaster” Lithuania.






The Palace of Art is a fine example of the integration of architecture, sculpture and ornamentation. The collaboration of various artists has resulted in a work of art with a compact and harmonious construction. This was determined by the occurrence of several pieces within one building, united by the uniform features of individual elements, variously named: Art Nouveau, Modernism and Symbolism.

After March 25, 1996, the reborn Board of the Society of the Friends of Fine Arts in Krakow, consisting of wonderful people from the world of science, culture, art and business, undertook and executed the task of saving and returning this magnificent Palace to its glory without national or local government subsidies. The exhibition area was increased by 60%, and the Lower Palace of Art was opened for use within 3 months. Now is the time for the Palace of Arts to fulfil the role for which it was created – a centre for the promotion of excellent Polish art, also through new walls in this area.

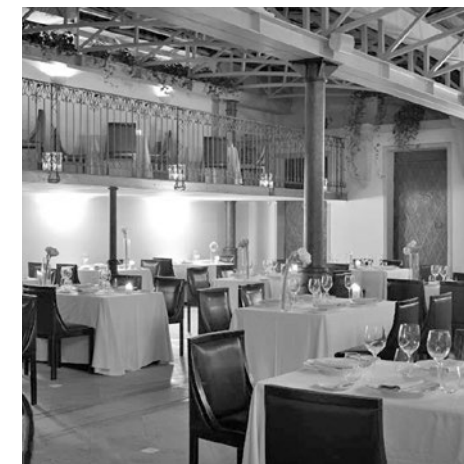

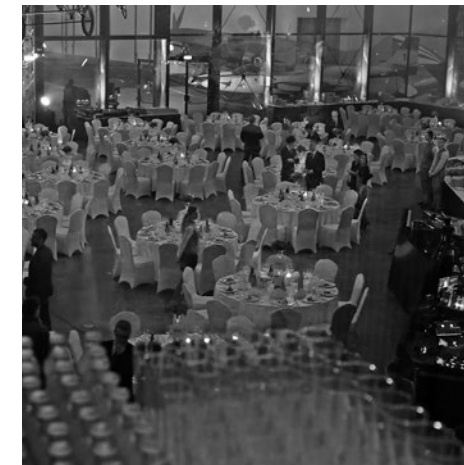
The building became the gate leading to the Museum, it introduces viewers into the world of the former airport and among others, prepares them to visit: the exhibition of the Great War Wing, devoted to aviation from World War I, the exhibition of aircraft collected in the historic Main Hangar of the pre-war Second Air Regiment, one from the world's largest aircraft engine collection or the exhibition "Between East and West. NATO vs the Agreement". The building has managed to successfully combine museum, educational, scientific and office functions - there are exhibition, educational, conference rooms and a modern science library with a reading room. The new investment has enabled a significant extension of the institution's offer - the Polish Aviation Museum has become one of the most desirable places in Krakow for organizing conferences, shows, presentations and celebrations, and the building itself has become one of Krakow's best examples of modern architecture, which has been confirmed by numerous awards.

The Home Army Museum in Kraków






All exhibits are displayed in a historic building constructed right before Great War as an element of the supply base of Austrian Krakow Fortress. The building, located nearly 300 meters away from the railway station, was used by the Polish Army during the Second Polish Republic and after World War II. 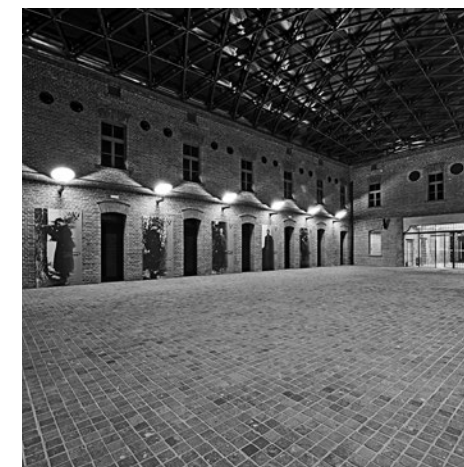

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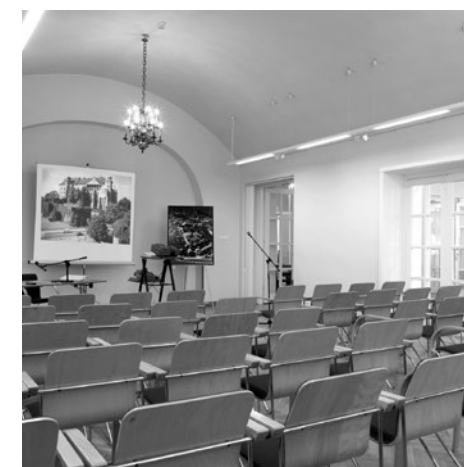

Workshop and Stained Glass Museum






A living museum where visitors can see the still functioning, oldest stained glass workshop in Poland (founded in 1902). The building was designed and built as dedicated for the studio's initial purposes, original furniture and equipment have been preserved. 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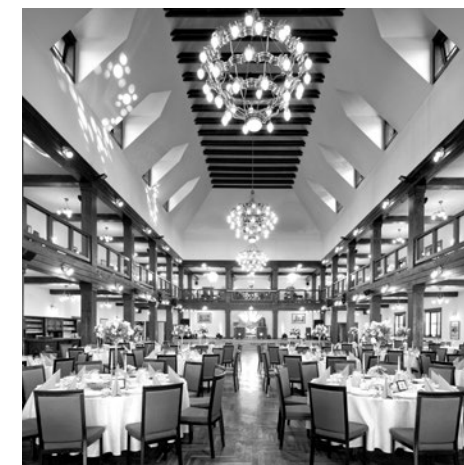
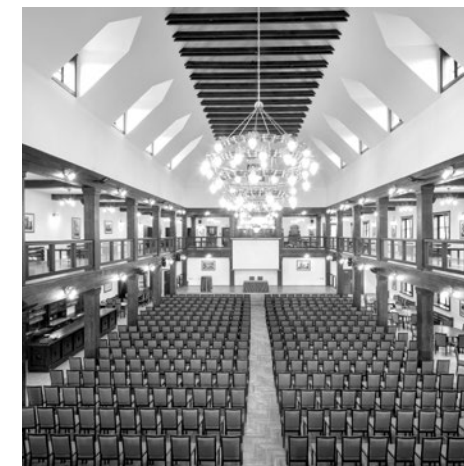
